- Don't use your built in microphone.
 - Paul Anderson of Bozeman Biology uses "Samson Go Mic Compact USB Microphone"
 - It's about \$40
- Don't ignore Audio Levels.
- Don't be just a Talking Head.
 - Hold pertinent items
 - Point at parts of the presentation
- Don't cut the video mid-sentence.
- Don't overuse transitions and effects.
- Don't go on at length without any visual change.
 - Add text or graphics
- Don't film outside (if you want to hear dialogue.)
 - wind and extraneous noises
- Don't have continuous background music.
